MASS OF REMEMBRANCE

To commemorate the life of your dearly departed loved one, our Parish would normally have A Remembrance Mass for all those who died beginning October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020, unfortunately this year because of the Pandemic and the restrictions on the number of people that can attend, we will be canceling the Mass this year. We will however add the names of your deceased loved ones in our Book of Remembrance and remember them at Mass during the month of November.
